

Dixie's Peach Dumpling Recipe

- 2 whole large peaches (Peel, pit, & cut into 8 slices)
(You can also substitute apples for the peaches)
- 2 sticks butter
- 2 8 oz. cans crescent rolls
- 1 ½ C. sugar
- 1 t. vanilla
- Cinnamon to taste
- 1 can orange soda



Roll each peach in a crescent roll. Place in a 9 X 13 dish.
Melt butter; lightly stir in sugar. Stir in vanilla & pour over peaches. Pour orange soda around the edges of the pan. Sprinkle with cinnamon & bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes.
