Raffia for tying baggies & scrolls
Paper cutter
Paper hole punch
Double-sided tape or glue
Tongue depressors

with the tongue depressor taped in between to
stick up over the soil.
Roll up "Cracked Pot" story & tie w/raffia. Place in
