As caregivers we are often exhausted just trying to keep up with the daily demands that we forget about the opportunity to apply for an **advanced election ballot** by mail for us and our loved one, so I have included the general election application in this newsletter.



Application for Advance Ballot by Mail

Voters are allowed to vote by mail prior to election day and must have your advance voting application for the 2024 general election to your county election official by October 29, in Kansas. Ballots will begin to be mailed on October 16th for those who apply. All ballots **MUST** be postmarked on or before election day and received in the county election office by the close of business on the third business day following the election.

November 5th Election Registration Application

I have also included the <u>link</u> and phone number to call if you have moved and need to update your name, address, or your party affiliation, or you need to register. Voter registration deadline for the November 05, 2024 election is Tuesday, October 15th, 2024 for **online, by mail, and in-person registration.** Return your completed application to *your* county.
