Paper Cutter

Scissors

Black ribbon

Copies of *Scripture Time Card*

Copies of *Like Sands through the Hourglass...*

Optional: add your organization's info on the back of the "Sands..."

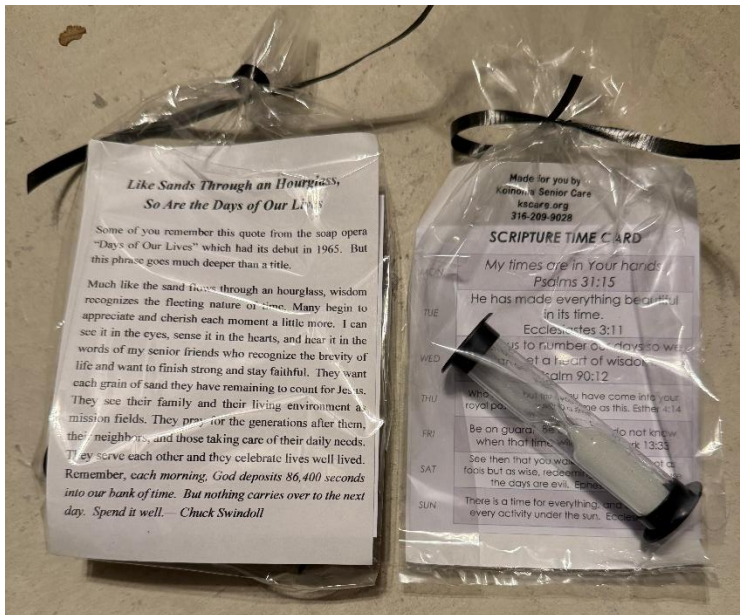
INSTRUCTIONS
